Last Thursday there were 14 students from Years 4, 5 and 6 that attended the Regional Athletics at Casey Fields in Cranbourne. These 14 children have been excellent competitors, progressing through both the District and Divisional Athletic Competitions to compete at the Regional level with an opportunity to compete at the State Athletics Championships if they finished in the top two in their chosen event.

The nerves were high amongst the competitors, however they all settled for each student to participate strongly. Particular note should be given to Dev (5/6W) who in the Discus competition had thrown a record 27.80m to advance from the Division to the Regionals Finals. At the Regional event he placed 4th after throwing a Personal Best of 28.50m. A fabulous effort!

Every student gave their best effort with one child advancing through

to the state championships. Grace (4WM) participated in the 10 year old girls, 100m sprint. She was placed 2nd in this competi-



-tion - being beaten in the last two steps by a fellow competitor. However her 2nd placed ranking gains her entry into the State Championships which are being held at the Lakeside Athletics Centre on the 24th October. Another fantastic effort! We wish Grace all the very best as she takes on the State.

Thanks once again to Mr Malone and Mrs Conway for their efforts to make our students excellent sporting competitors.

University of NSW Mathematics Testing

Monday’s Assembly was as usual, filled with the success stories of our students from various fields! This was highlighted by the exceptional results that our children received as part of the University of New South Wales Mathematical Assessments.

This year, there were 75 students who participated in the Mathematics test with over 50% of children achieving a High Distinction, Distinction, Credit or Merit Certificate.

Three children achieved a High Distinction - placing them in the top 1% of students across

Australia. Congratulations to Reshmi (4R), Alex (5/6H) and Jiadong (5/6H)! This is a fabulous effort considering the complexity of the test.

Lazar (3S), Jamie (3M), Simone (5/6F), Dev (5/6W) and Vinusakini (5/6H) all received a Distinction certificate for their Mathematics test, achieving in the top 10% in Australia.

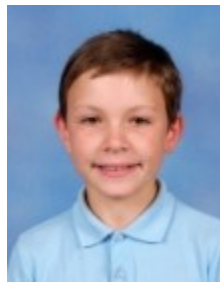

Mr Malone again presented Malone Medallions to two worthy athletes at this Monday's Assembly.

The first awardee was for Dev (5/6W) who Mr Malone highlighted was a wonderful role model for others as he could be seen playing cricket at both recess and lunchtimes - highlighting his preference and abilities within this chosen sport.

Dev has never participated in the Cross Country, however he always tries his hardest during the 15 minute run! In 2014 he placed 4th in the District triple jump and high jump.

In 2015 he participated in the long jump at the Divisional level placing 4th.

This year, he placed 1st in the discus, 1st in triple jump and was 2nd in the relay at the District level. He placed 1st in the Discus at the Divisionals and then 4th at the Regionals.

A great effort Dev!

The second Malone Medallion recipient was Stephanie (5/6C).

She has been a Cross Country participant in 2014 placing 3rd, 7th in the Divisional Cross Country and 30th at the Region.

In 2015 she placed 8th at the District level - however went away on holidays so could not compete



at the next level.

This year in 2016, she placed 7th in the District and 15th at the Division levels.

She has participated in the AFL team on Gala Day 1 and Netball at Gala Days 2 and 3.

Her athletics saw her compete at the Region in 2014 placing 4th in the relay.

In 2015 she placed 4th in the 100m at the Districts and 4th in the 200m .

This year Stephanie placed 2nd in the 100m at the District and 4th in the 100m at the Regional Athletics carnival.

Stephanie is a great example of a person who continually tries her best!

Hats For Term Four
