DNPS has often performed well at athletic events in both the District and Regional meets - however it has been at least 12 years since we have had a State Finalist! One of our last entrants was Adam Treloar who is now a sought after AFL player for Collingwood.

The competition at these events is always tough and Monday's meet was no different. Grace ran in the first heat of the 100m placing 3rd - which allowed her a spot in the final.

As you can well imagine, the final race was a nerve wracking affair for Grace! However, she was step for step with the leader at the half way mark, finally finishing fifth in the race with a time of 14.4 seconds which was only 2 tenths of a second behind the winner.
