Phased Return to Onsite Learning

Welcome back to term 4! There was some great news over the holiday period with the return to school for students being phased in. All staff are thrilled to have a staggered return of students culminating in the return of all students on November 5th. We are sure that this will be a highly celebrated day for the whole community.

Plans for parents and students have been put in place to ensure that Dandenong North stays COVID safe. They include:

- Proper Face Masks MUST be worn over nose and mouth as a condition of ADULT entry.
- A minimum distance of 1.5 metres between adults MUST be maintained by ALL adults at ALL times.
- If parents or carers do not need to come into the school grounds, then please do not, so that we can minimise adult movements and contact with each other.
- Children will enter the grounds and place their bag outside of their classroom. If parents have come onsite to make sure that their child goes to the correct room, we then ask that parents and carers leave the school grounds as quickly as possible.
- Children in Years 3 to 6 MUST wear a face mask correctly. It is also recommended that children in Prep – Year 2 also wear a mask – however this is not mandated by the Department.
- Students will line up outside of their classroom at the end of the day, and parents can collect them. However, once again, if you DO NOT have to come on to school grounds – then please refrain from doing so.

To further assist with maintaining of community safety, we will not be allowing parents or carers access to any of the school buildings. Parents who need to speak to reception or office staff will need to call 9794 7899 or knock on the front door before entry. Our staff can then assist you outside if needed. Masks must be worn if entering the office and you must check in using the OR code supplied.

Most importantly we are seeking the assistance of our families to keep our community safe by keeping children at home who show any sign of illness. It has been a long time for our children to be undertaking home learning, and all it takes is one positive COVID case and the school would be closed and children would again be disadvantaged by working remotely. This is something that we all must do to keep our community members safe.

We thank the community members of Dandenong North, for all of the support that they have shown the school. We need this to continue once we are all back onsite and if you are unwell, then please get tested.



School Owned - Borrowed

Once children have returned to full time onsite learning (5th November), we ask that parents remove from their child, all school owned borrowed devices. This is because students will no longer require these devices for EDUCA-TIONAL purposes.

However, with the current high level of COVID cases, and the recent history of snap lockdowns being called, we will extend the loan of school owned devices until Tuesday 30th November. This is a precaution to ensure that if a lockdown is called, our students will have quick access to devices and they will be ready to undertake online learning if needed.

As of Wednesday, 1st December we ask that all children return loaned devices to the school. Class teachers will



It is important that each device is returned in the condition that it was borrowed, as all of these devices are used at school to assist children with their learning.

Once all devices are returned, they will then need to be cleaned and reimaged before they can be used in classrooms again.

We thank you for your assistance with this matter.



Currently there are major stormwater works occurring on David Street, located directly in front of the school. Between Woodlee Street and the intersection of Cleeland and David Streets, the road is closed.. That means that there is no parent access via car. These works are continuing until the middle of November, meaning that no children will be able to be dropped off or picked up outside the front of the school. Alternative arrangements will need to be made and we are asking for our families to use patience when parking in neighbouring streets. Please speak with your child/ren and let them know that if they have not been collected by 3.30, to make their way to the soccer pitch in front of the office and to wait patiently for their parent/carer to arrive.
