School Uniform

Recently at DNPS, we have noticed some variations of our school uniform, particularly amongst children in years 4-6. We would like to remind all parents that our school uniform colours are navy and sky blue. As per our School Uniform policy that is published on the DNPS website, children should be wearing navy blue pants, shorts or leggings, a sky blue polo shirt (with or without the school logo) in Year P-5 or the navy Year 6 polo for Year 6 students and a navy blue jumper. A blue and white check dress may also be worn by girls. No black, labelled or free dress jumpers should be worn to school. Please review your child's school uniform to ensure it fits the above requirements. Items can be purchased from all major department stores including Kmart, Target, BigW and Best & Less. Alternatively, State School Relief in Dandenong South are our official uniform supplier and can be found at 1/8 Johnston Court Dandenong South or contact 8769 8400.

Be prepared for cold weather: Please encourage your child to bring (and wear) a navy blue-jumper and jacket during recess and lunch. Jackets are also permitted to be worn in the school yard.

End of day school pick up

With the onset of cooler and wetter weather, we would like to remind all parents and carers that school finishes at 3.15. Unfortunately we do not have an appropriate shelter for children to be waiting to be collected so request that you make arrangements to collect your child as close to 3.15 as possible to ensure they are not out in the cold or rain while they wait.

PREP ENROLMENTS:

There has been a new statewide timeline for enrolling in Prep for the 2024 school year, with guidelines around dates being mandated. Therefore, if you have a child starting primary school in 2024, it's time to enrol. Every application must be submitted before Friday 28th July 2023. If you currently have a child attending DNPS and a new sibling beginning in 2024, your child will be prioritised at our school as per the Department's Placement Policy. We encourage you to visit the school office at your earliest convenience to complete an enrolment form (you will require your child's birth certificate or passport and their Medicare Immunisation Certificate).

4Cs Day! Celebrating our values of


Care, Courtesy, Cooperation and Common Sense


