

PREP ENROLMENTS:

There has been a new statewide timeline for enrolling in Prep for the 2024 school year, with guidelines around dates being mandated. Therefore, <u>if you have a child starting primary school in 2024</u>, <u>it's time to enrol</u>. Every application must be submitted before Friday 28th July 2023. If you currently have a child attending DNPS and a new sibling beginning in 2024, your child will be prioritised at our school as per the Department's Placement Policy. We encourage you to visit the school office at your earliest convenience to complete an enrolment form (you will require your child's birth certificate or passport and their Medicare Immunisation Certificate).



Wellbeing Matters

Read aloud to boost your child's vocabulary!

Words can be powerful tools and a rich vocabulary can provide our children with better health and academic outcomes. Daily conversations with your child will be the steppingstone to securing your child's vocabulary. An expanding vocabulary bank will also provide the child with the ability to express themselves more clearly and in turn, regulate their own behaviours. Children draw on their vocabulary to communicate verbally and in the written form and their vocabulary choices will optimise the clarity and accuracy of their expression. There is also a clear link between vocabularv and the success of reading comprehension and word recognition skills.

Reading together can also provide some valuable parent-child bonding time. It can strengthen the relationship between parent and child which in turn supports their emotional wellbeing.



<u>Strategies to encourage vocabulary development:</u>

When you are reading with your child and you encounter a new word, you may pause and ask the child what they think it means. If they are unsure, provide some context from the story and give some clues about the meaning. Provide them with the definition if they are still unclear.

Using gestures such as pointing, providing definitions, asking questions about new words can assist in developing vocabulary.

It is also useful to read the same story several times to strengthen the retention of new words.

Use a variety of words to describe the different characters in a story and what they are doing e.g. The brave/courageous/prince fell/dropped/plunged into the water.

Keep track of new words e.g. create a whiteboard word bank on your fridge and add to it each day. Have the word bank somewhere around the house where you are likely to see it often to increase exposure.

If you don't have access to a book, you can always tell your child a story! Storytelling can also benefit vocabulary building and it is a great way to connect with your child.

We have a 'Free Little Library' at our school, so feel free to take a book home ③ OR borrow some books from Dandenong Library (225 Lonsdale St, Dandenong)
