Thank you to all of the parents and students who have embraced the second instalment of remote learning. It is important that children continue to take the time to work through their daily tasks, based on the timetable provided each day, and to seek assistance from their teacher when required.

We are now in a position to provide electronic devices, such as computers or iPads to our families. Last week, classroom teachers were identifying families who require devices to support remote learning. These devices can be collected at the same time as the learning packs, from the bottom floor of the double storey portable next to the covered area, the “Aircraft Hangar” on Friday 31st July.

From week three of remote learning, students in Prep to Year 4 will be using a combination of online learning and learning packs for children to complete each day. Years 5 & 6 will complete all lessons online from week 3. Children who attend EAL will also continue to receive a learning pack.

We will distribute Learning Packs for remote learning on **Friday 31st July** under the covered area, the ‘Aircraft Hangar’. In order to protect the health of our families, we have staggered the collection of packs to adhere to social distancing rules.

Please find below the list of times for pack and device collection:

Friday 31st July Learning Pack & Device Collection Times

- 9:30 to 10:30** Children’s last names that begin with the letter A, B, C, D or E.
- 10:30 to 11:30** Children’s last names that begin with the letter F, G, H, I or J.
- 11:30 to 12:30** Children’s last names that begin with the letter K, L, M, N or O.
- 12:30 to 1:30** Children’s last names that begin with the letter P, Q, R, S or T.
- 1:30 to 2:30** Children’s last names that begin with the letter U, V, W, X, Y or Z.

It is important that children “log on” to their device each morning to complete attendance requirements and to see the outlined timetable. We will continue to aim to contact families or children regularly so that questions can be answered and learning can be monitored.

The Junior and Senior Libraries will be open once again for children on this day to return and borrow books. We ask that parents encourage their children to read each day and if possible listen to them read out loud.

Please note, when you are entering the school grounds, maintain a social distance of 1.5 metres. The Victorian Government requires all people over the age of 12 to wear a face mask when leaving their home. Therefore we would appreciate the wearing of face-masks when entering the school grounds. Children 12 years and under are not required to wear a face mask, but are free to wear them also.
